# Policy of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

### 1. Introduction

ISBM University recognizes the importance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in fostering innovation, creativity, and entrepreneurship. This policy outlines the principles and guidelines governing the creation, protection, ownership, and commercialization of intellectual property generated within the university ecosystem.

# 2. Objectives

- To promote a culture of innovation and creativity among students, faculty, and staff.
- To provide clarity on ownership, protection, and commercialization of intellectual property.
- To incentivize and reward individuals and teams for their contributions to intellectual property creation.
- To facilitate the transfer of technology and knowledge to benefit society and the economy.

# 3. Scope

This policy applies to all intellectual property created, developed, or discovered by students, faculty, and staff of ISBM University, including but not limited to:

- Inventions, patents, and patentable ideas.
- Copyrighted works such as books, articles, software, and artistic creations.
- Trademarks, service marks, and brand identities.
- Trade secrets and know-how.
- Designs, prototypes, and tangible research materials.

# 4. Ownership

- Intellectual property created by students, faculty, and staff in the course of their duties or using university resources shall be owned by ISBM University.
- In cases where external funding or collaboration agreements are involved, ownership rights shall be determined as per the terms of the agreement.
- Students, faculty, and staff shall be entitled to equitable compensation and recognition for their contributions to intellectual property.

### 5. Protection

• ISBM University shall take appropriate measures to protect intellectual property rights through patents, copyrights, trademarks, and other forms of legal protection.
